Open Water Students will complete and log 4 Scuba Dives over 2 days.

(Please confirm your scheduled dive time the day before.)

You must be on the roster to dive at Scuba Nashville Dive training quarry. Please print and bring liability waiver.

\$25 Entrance Fee Per Day

Please bring cash or check. If you wish to pay with credit card there will be a 4% fee.

The 4 scuba check-out dives are completed over 2 days. I provide the scuba gear, tanks, regulator, weights and B.C.D. <u>You should have your own mask, fins and snorkel.</u> You might want to wear a wetsuit. If you don't have your own wetsuit and I have one in your size, you may rent one from me for \$10.

You will need a logbook to log the dives. Logbooks cost \$10 and \$25.

During the 4 check-out dives, your instructor will ask you to demonstrate the skills you learned in the pool. After each dive, we will log them in your logbook and after the fourth dive you'll be a certified PADI Scuba Diver. I'll give you a temporary Scuba Certification Card good for 90 days. Your official certification card will arrive from PADI in a couple of weeks.

I need your picture for your certification card. Email it or bring it to me before the last dive.

Scuba Gear Required for Open Water Check-out Dives:

Open Water students completing training dives receive FREE rental for your BCD, Regulator, Tanks, and Weights. Advanced students and higher should have your own gear. Rentals: BCD \$10, Regulator \$10, Tank \$10, Mask \$5, Fins \$5, Wetsuit \$10

Your Required Personal Equipment;

1. Mask, Fins and Snorkel: You may rent them from Scuba Nashville for \$10 each day.

2. Logbook: All your training dives must be logged and signed by your instructor.

3. **Wetsuit:** Depends on water temperature. You may rent one from a dive shop the day before you go to the quarry or from me for \$10. I have limited sizes of wetsuits.

Each day you'll be at the quarry for about 3 or 4 hours. I'll bring a cooler filled with water. You may want to bring a snack and stay all day and play. Once you are certified, you may borrow a free tank and go on a fun dive with your certified dive buddy.

> Bring a chair, shade and snacks. You may even bring a grill if you want. I'll have a cooler with bottled water.

The closest bathroom and food is a half mile away at the corner of I-40 and McCrory. McCrory Lane Quarry is private property.

You must be on the Scuba Nashville roster to be on the property.



Non-Agency Disclosure and Acknowledgment Agreement

Liability Release and Assumption of Risk Agreement

I, ______, hereby affirm that I am aware that skin and scuba diving have inherent risks which may result in serious injury or death.

I understand that diving with compressed air involves certain inherent risks; including but not limited to decompression sickness, embolism or other hyperbaric/ air expansion injury that require treatment in a recompression chamber. I further understand that the open water diving trips which are necessary for training and for certification may be conducted at a site that is remote, either by time or distance or both, from such a recompression chamber. I still choose to proceed with such instructional dives in spite of the possible absence of a recompression chamber in proximity to the dive site.

I understand and agree that neither my instructor(s), <u>instructor(s)</u>, the facility through which I receive my instruction, <u>store/resort</u>, nor PADI Americas, Inc., nor its affiliate and subsidiary corporations, nor any of their respective employees, officers, agents, contractors or assigns (hereinafter referred to as "Released Parties") may be held liable or responsible in any way for any injury, death or other damages to me, my family, estate, heirs or assigns that may occur as a result of my participation in this diving program or as a result of the negligence of any party, including the Released Parties, whether passive or active.

In consideration of being allowed to participate in this course (and optional Adventure Dive), hereinafter referred to as "program," I hereby personally assume all risks of this program, whether foreseen or unforeseen, that may befall me while I am a participant in this program including, but not limited to, the academics, confined water and/or open water activities.

I further release, exempt and hold harmless said program and Released Parties from any claim or lawsuit by me, my family, estate, heirs or assigns, arising out of my enrollment and participation in this program including both claims arising during the program or after I receive my certification.

I also understand that skin diving and scuba diving are physically strenuous activities and that I will be exerting myself during this program, and that if I am injured as a result of heart attack, panic, hyperventilation, drowning or any other cause, that I expressly assume the risk of said injuries and that I will not hold the Released Parties responsible for the same.

I further state that I am of lawful age and legally competent to sign this liability release, or that I have acquired the written consent of my parent or guardian. I understand the terms herein are contractual and not a mere recital, and that I have signed this Agreement of my own free act and with the knowledge that I hereby agree to waive my legal rights. I further agree that if any provision of this Agreement is found to be unenforceable or invalid, that provision shall be severed from this Agreement. The remainder of this Agreement will then be construed as though the unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.

I understand and agree that I am not only giving up my right to sue the Released Parties but also any rights my heirs, assigns, or beneficiaries may have to sue the Released Parties resulting from my death. I further represent I have the authority to do so and that my heirs, assigns, or beneficiaries will be estopped from claiming otherwise because of my representations to the Released Parties.
